EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes all hunting in a portion of GMU 14A to compliment the Department of Natural Resources public order in the Deshka Landing Fire Area. All hunting is closed in the affected area until further notice.

On August 22 the Department of Natural Resources Division of Forestry restricted access in an area associated with active fire suppression for the Dshka Landing Fire Area.
