### **Trophy Fish - Based on Weight Minimum Weights to Qualify**

<b>Species</b>	<b>Min. Weight</b>
<b>Arctic Char/Dolly Varden</b>	10 pounds
<b>Brook Trout</b>	3 pounds
<b>Burbot</b>	8 pounds
<b>Chum salmon</b>	15 pounds
<b>Coho salmon</b>	20 pounds
<b>Cutthroat trout (sea-run)</b>	3 pounds
<b>Arctic grayling</b>	3 pounds
<b>Halibut</b>	250 pounds
<b>King salmon (from Kenai River)</b>	75 pounds
<b>King salmon (from other waters)</b>	50 pounds
<b>Lake trout</b>	20 pounds
<b>Lingcod</b>	55 pounds
<b>Northern pike</b>	15 pounds
<b>Pink salmon</b>	8 pounds
<b>Nonpelagic Rockfish (see <i>qualifying species on next page</i>)</b>	18 pounds
<b>Pelagic Rockfish (see <i>qualifying species on next page</i>)</b>	10 pounds
<b>Rainbow/Steelhead trout</b>	15 pounds
<b>Sheefish</b>	30 pounds
<b>Sockeye salmon</b>	12 pounds
<b>Whitefish</b>	4 pounds

Minimum weights for Trophy Fish certificates are listed in the table above. Entries must be weighed in the presence of a witness and a Trophy Fish Official (can be the same person) and on a scale certified by the Division of Weights and Measures.

## Nonpelagic rockfish

While any nonpelagic rockfish species would qualify for a trophy based on weight, the more commonly caught nonpelagic rockfish that would generally meet the minimum weight requirements include, yelloweye, silvergray, shortraker, and roughey. Always use a deepwater release mechanism to release rockfish that are not harvested.

## Pelagic rockfish

While any pelagic rockfish species would qualify for a trophy based on weight, the more commonly caught pelagic rockfish that would generally meet the minimum weight requirements include, black, yellowtail, and widow.
