Serious consideration and answers should be provided at the ABOF meeting on the urgency of the subject matter, efficient time in the current processes, and sufficient time for the public to travel to attend Alaska Board of Fisheries meeting to provide input to the Board on fisheries proposals or other subject matters that are brought before the Alaska Board of Fisheries.
