


#### King Salmon Escapement











#### **Northern District Commercial Fishery Statistical Harvest Areas**





#### Northern District Early Season King Salmon Harvest





### Tyonek Subsistence Harvest Locations

- 3 actions with various options listed to achieve goal.
- Objective of actions = Reduce harvest.
  - ➤ Sport Fishery
  - Commercial Fishery
  - ➤ Subsistence Fishery

- Option E Close Entire Northern District.


