Notice is given that the Alaska Board of Fisheries (board) will meet by teleconference on **Thursday, July 26, 8:30 a.m.** The purpose of the meeting is to consider a petition concerning Cook Inlet setnet closure. The petition requests that setnet fishing in the East Forelands statistical area of Cook Inlet be opened to help keep the Kenai River late-run sockeye salmon escapement within the range set by regulation.
