Without belaboring the specifics here, we strongly urge the Board not to adopt any of these proposals because of their potential for serious negative impacts to this important \$4 million industry. Stability in this fishery is vital and we urge the Board to maintain status quo on these matters, not only for the sac roe fishery but for the Bristol Bay salmon industry as well, due to interrelated economies of the tender fleet and processors that serve both fisheries.
