Substitute Language for proposal 6;

5AAC 55.023 is amended to read:

(1)(A) from August 15 – September 15 in all freshwater drainages crossed by the Copper River Highway from and including Eyak River to the Million Dollar Bridge, including Clear Creek at mile 42, after taking and retaining a bag limit of coho salmon 16 inches or greater in length, a person may not sport fish with bait for the remainder of that day in these drainages.
