Commercial fishing is the lifeblood of our community. Access to safer fishing grounds closer to tewn along the rough line from Ocean Cape to Pt. Manby on the north shore of 'akutat Bay will be improved by moving the line outward as described in #220. It is vital to our fleet that they be able to access grounds that are better protected from harsh Gulf of Alaska winter weather. As it is now, fishermen must tradel further out to the other side of the Bay, increasing run times and making for greater exposure to rough weather. Our local government would like to see our fishermen have a safer and more efficient way to fish on winter kings. We do not see a major conservation issue with the adjustment of
