- 5 AAC 29.100. MANAGEMENT OF THE SUMMER SALMON TROLL FISHERY.
- (b) The department shall manage the summer king salmon troll fishery as follows:
- (2) in order to provide for the harvest of the remaining portion of the king salmon harvest following <u>any</u> [a]coho salmon closure, the department shall manage the king salmon harvest as follows:
- (D) if the department determines that the amount of king salmon remaining on the annual troll harvest ceiling is insufficient to allow a competitive fishery, the commissioner may, by emergency order, reopen the troll fishery to the taking of king salmon during which a limited harvest fishery is in effect subject to the following requirements:
 - 1) <u>a limited harvest fishery may be opened for up to 10 days, opening no earlier than September 1.</u>
 - 2) the remaining king salmon will be distributed equally amongst all troll participants.
 - 3) king salmon retained during a limited harvest fishery must be kept separate from all other salmon on board.
 - 4) both commercially sold and personal use king salmon retained during a limited harvest fishery count toward the harvest limit specified under the provisions of a limited harvest fishery.
 - 5) a copy of fish tickets documenting commercially sold or personal use king salmon retained during a limited harvest fishery must be kept on board the vessel while operating gear in a limited harvest fishery and during transits to or from a port of landing.
 - 6) fish tickets must be made available to a local representative of the department upon request.
 - 7) following the end of a limited harvest fishing period, all king salmon must be offloaded prior to resuming fishing for other salmon species.
 - 8) any provisions the commissioner determines necessary to conduct a limited harvest fishery.
