- The are four proposals that seek to reallocate from the federal p-cod fisheries (and the parallel fishery) to the statewater GHL fisheries.
- The parallel fishery is a statewater fishery. The proposals involve allocation from federal to state but also between two statewaters fisheries – the parallel fishery and the GHL fishery.
- The BOF allocation criteria should be applied and considered during the deliberations.

BOF Allocation Criteria

Area and Allocation


- U.S. portion of Bering Sea = 382,227 sq miles.
- Approximately 43% is deep-water basin; 13% slope; and 44% continental shelf.
- Most cod fishing occurs on the shelf area (168,180 sq miles) of which half of that is considered p-cod fishing grounds (**84,090 sq mi**).

- The approximate area of the statewater Dutch Harbor sub-district is **840 square miles** (or < 1% of the area of Bering Sea p-cod fishing grounds) Additionally, portions of the DH sub-district are closed to fishing for SSL management.
- Current allocation to statewater GHL in Area O/Dutch Harbor is **3%** (established in 2014).
- Proposals seek to increase the allocation in this small area to **7% or 9%**.

Area and Allocation (con't)


Concentration of p-cod harvest in Dutch Harbor GHL p-cod fishery


- Presently, GHL is **3%** of the BSAI p-cod ABC in **less than 1%** of the EBS p-cod grounds.
- Proposals would further concentrate up to **7% to 9%** of the EBS p-cod ABC in **less than 1%** of the EBS p-cod grounds.



Essential Fish Habitat for Pacific Cod (late juvenile and adult)


Footprint of the EBS p-cod longline fishery: The most spatially distributed cod fishery - which avoids over-concentration of harvest that can lead to localized depletion.





The EBS trawl p-cod fishery is also spatially well distributed (with some concentration in "cod alley")

The **EBS p-cod pot federal fishery** is the least spatially distributed cod fishery and is concentrated in the Unimak area (as is the GHL fishery).
