

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING OF THE
ALASKA BOARD OF FISHERIES**


Notice is given that the Alaska Board of Fisheries will expand its special meeting on **Wednesday, May 17, 2017**, starting at 1:00 p.m. to review an emergency petition by the Fairbanks Fish and Game Advisory Committee. The board's special meeting on the Bering Sea Tanner Crab Harvest Strategy, to be held May 17-18, will include at the very beginning of the meeting a review of the emergency petition requesting the board consider a number of measures to limit the harvest of king salmon in the Prince William Sound commercial salmon fishery.

The meeting will occur in Anchorage at the Sheraton Hotel, 401 East 6th Avenue, Kuskokwim Room. The board will not take oral public testimony in its consideration of the emergency petition.

The Board will provide additional notice of, and opportunity to comment on, any further regulatory action on this topic, including any action to make an amendment permanent. The Board may also delegate to the Commissioner authority to take regulatory action on this topic.
