Alaska Board of Game July 7, 2008 Emergency Meeting Unit 13 Tier II Scoring and Hunting Regulations

Meeting Summary

The Board of Game met July 2, 2008, in Anchorage at the Residence Inn located at 10258 35th Avenue. The meeting convened at 1:22 p.m. Five board members were present: Chairman Cliff Judkins, Ben Grussendorf, Dick Burley, Bob Bell, and Lew Bradley. Members Ted Spraker and Craig Fleener were absent.

Listen in sites for the public were available in Anchorage, Juneau, and Glennallen. A live audio stream of the meeting was available online.

The purpose of the board meeting was to consider emergency regulations concerning Tier II scoring and subsistence hunting regulations for Unit 13 as a result of a June 5, 2008 Superior Court decision.

The board took the following actions:

- 1. The board adopted a finding of emergency concerning moose hunting in Unit 13 and the Tier II subsistence permit point system for Tier II hunts in Unit 13.
- 2. The board voted down a motion to change the amount reasonably necessary (ANS) for subsistence for moose to 250 for Unit 13.
- 3. The board adopted emergency regulations to change the Unit 13 general moose hunt to a subsistence hunt, and to eliminate the scoring of an applicant's income for Tier II hunts in Unit 13.
