This proposal would specify criteria for accepting ACRs, require an earlier submission, and add a provision for coordinating with federal actions. (prepared 4-19-11)

5 AAC 92.005. Policy for changing board agenda.

(a) The Board of Game, will, in its discretion, change its schedule for considering proposed regulatory changes <u>in response to an agenda change request, submitted on a</u> <u>form provided by the board,</u> in accordance with the following guidelines:

(1) a request to consider a proposed regulatory change outside the board's published schedule must [BE IN WRITING AND MUST] specify the change proposed and the reason it should be considered out of sequence;

(2) the board will accept an agenda change request only

(A) for a conservation purpose or reason;

(B) to correct an error in a regulation; or

(C) to correct an effect on a hunt that was unforeseen when a regulation was adopted;

(3) the board will not accept an agenda change request that is predominantly allocative in nature in the absence of new information that is found by the board to be compelling;

(4) [(2)] a request must be sent to the executive director of the boards support section at least $\underline{60}$ [45] days before a scheduled meeting unless the board allows an exception to the deadline because of an emergency;

(3) the executive director shall attempt to obtain comments on the request from as many board members as can be contacted; and [(4)] if a majority of the board members contacted approve the request, the executive director shall notify the public and the department of the agenda change <u>and when the board will consider the</u> <u>proposed regulatory change requested;</u>

(b) The board will, in its discretion, change its schedule for consideration of proposed regulatory changes as reasonably necessary for coordination of state regulatory actions with federal agencies, programs, or laws.

The Board of Game will accept an agenda change request only:

- 1) for a conservation purpose or reason; or
- 2) to correct an error in regulation; or

The board will not accept an agenda change request that is predominantly allocative in nature in the absence of new information found by the board to be compelling (5 AAC 92.005).
