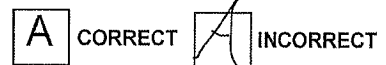

Remember...

- Applicants may be awarded a maximum of one permit per species. Each household may be awarded a maximum of one Tier II Moose permit and one Tier II Muskox permit. Applications must be postmarked on or before Dec. 15, and received before Dec. 29.

Providing false information on this application is subject to a maximum penalty of either a \$10,000 fine or 1 year imprisonment, or both, per 5 AAC 92.020, 5 AAC 92.062, AS 16.05.420, AS 16.05.925 and AS 11.56.210. If requested by ADF&G or Alaska Wildlife Troopers to provide additional information to support answers on your application, you must comply or you will be cited.

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- 1. Driver's License or State ID Number.**
Enter your Alaska Driver's License or State ID Number.
- 2. Date of Birth (REQUIRED)**
Enter your birth date. You must be at least 10 years old by starting date of hunt.

3-9. Personal Information (REQUIRED)
Print your first name, middle initial and last name. Be sure to include Jr., III, etc. after your last name. Use only capital letters. Remember: your physical address is required if different from your mailing address.
- Your personal information is required in order to mail application results.

10-13. Community of Principal Residence (REQUIRED)
Enter the community name that is the "true and permanent home from which you have no present intention of moving and to which you intend to return whenever you are away." This is the physical address where you reside the majority of the time and does not include a recreation cabin or a part-time residence. You may claim only one location as your principal residence.

14. Residency (REQUIRED)
Enter the total years you have resided in Alaska. An Alaska resident is a person who is physically present in Alaska with the intent to remain indefinitely and make a home here, and has maintained that person's domicile (home) in Alaska for the 12 consecutive months immediately preceding this application.

15. Applying for Tier II Hunt (REQUIRED)
Enter the correct hunt number for which you are applying by writing the letter of the species and the 3-digit number for the hunt. For example, if you want to apply for hunt TM565, you would complete the box like this:

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16. If you are applying for MORE THAN one Tier II hunt for this species Enter the number that indicates if the hunt you are applying for is your 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc. choice for that species. For example enter a 1 if this is your first choice. You may apply for multiple hunts per species, but may only receive one Tier II permit for that species. If you qualify for more than one permit per species, your hunt choice preference determines which permit you will receive.

Questions 17-20 are SCORED - If a question is left blank, you will receive the minimum score on that question.

17. Total years YOU have hunted or eaten meat from this population
Enter the number of years you have hunted or eaten meat from the game population you are applying for in question 15.
- 1.0 point is awarded for each year, for a maximum of 50 points.

18. Total years any one household member has hunted or eaten meat from this population. A household member is any person currently living with you in your principal home, excluding persons boarding or renting within your home or relatives living in separate homes. Enter the total number of years this household member has hunted or eaten meat from this game population you are applying for in question 15.
- .20 points are awarded each year, for a maximum of 10 points.

19. Within the last regulatory year, how many days did you (the applicant) spend hunting and/or fishing in this Tier II hunt area? Check the box that corresponds with the correct number of days you spent hunting and fishing. For example, since July 1, 2008, if you fished for 14 days in this hunt area and then hunted for 10 days in this hunt area, your total days would equal 24. Select the box marked "7-27" days.
- Applicants can score a maximum of 25 points for the question.

20 & 21: Community Questions. Enter the community that correctly answers these question. See Tier II supplement for a list of Alaska communities.
- For question 20, applicant can score a maximum of 25 points.
- For question 21, applicants can score a maximum of 30 points.
