**EXPLANATION:**

This emergency order closes the resident and nonresident brown bear hunting season in the following portions of hunt area RB077; (1) that portion including all of Chichagof Island and adjacent small islands north of Salisbury Sound (including Yakobi and other adjacent islands), Peril Strait (including Emmons and Moser islands), Hoonah Sound and north of the Peril Strait-Chatham Strait junction. This emergency order takes effect at 11:59 PM, October 5, 2011.

**REGULATION:**

Therefore, the provisions of **5 AAC 85.020, Hunting seasons and bag limits for brown bear**, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective:

The remainder of Unit 4 brown bear season, other than those closed by emergency order, are not affected by this emergency order.

**JUSTIFICATION:**

Biologists have set a maximum guideline harvest objective of 14 males or 3 female bears allowed for that portion of Unit 4 (RB077) including all of Chichagof Island and adjacent small islands north of Salisbury Sound (including Yakobi and other adjacent islands), Peril Strait (including Emmons and Moser islands), Hoonah Sound and north of the Peril Strait-Chatham Strait junction. As of Friday, September 30, 2011, five female bears have been reported harvested. Because the guideline harvest of sows has been exceeded in this area, an emergency order is being issued to close the brown bear hunting season at 11:59 pm, Wednesday, October 5, 2011. The emergency order action is necessary to restrict the harvest to the guideline level, and to prevent overharvest in this area. Any additional harvest of female bears could have long-term negative effects on this bear population.
