### EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the State of Alaska resident and nonresident mountain goat registration permit hunt RG232 (Scott Glacier – Rude River) in Game Management Unit 6(C). Mountain goat hunting regulations in all other portions of Game Management Unit 6 are not affected by this emergency order.

### REGULATION:


Therefore, the following regulations in 5AAC 85.040(a)(2), **Hunting Seasons and Bag Limits for Goat**, are superseded by this emergency order and the following provisions are effective:

(2) Unit 6(C), Hunt RG232: specifically, that portion of Unit 6(C) west of Scott Glacier, north of the Copper River Highway.	Oct. 7 – Oct. 25	Oct. 7 – Oct. 25

1 goat by registration permit only.

All other mountain goat hunting regulations in  
Unit 6 are not affected by this emergency order

**JUSTIFICATION:**

Recent aerial surveys yielded a count of 65 goats in registration permit area RG232. Maximum allowable harvest this year under the State of Alaska hunt was set at 2 goats. Reported harvest is now 1 nanny. Each nanny counts as 2 toward the harvest quota. Any additional take could harm stability of the population.
