EXPLANATION:

This announcement opens the state resident moose hunting season in the portion of Game Management Unit 26B excluding Canning River drainage. The bag limit is one bull.

REGULATION:

Therefore, the following regulations in **5AAC 85.045(a)(24), HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR MOOSE**, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are in effect for hunting moose in Unit 26B, excluding the Canning River drainage:

All other moose hunting regulations in Unit 26B remain unchanged and are not affected by this emergency order.

JUSTIFICATION:

The moose population in 26B has been steadily increasing since a decline in 2014 to a population of less than 110 moose. The 2023 population estimate was 359 moose and is sufficient to open a general hunting season. The hunt area is Unit 26B, excluding the Canning River drainage. The hunt area includes part of the Dalton Highway Corridor Management Area (DHCMA). Moose may be taken in the DHCMA by bow and arrow only, and bowhunter education certification is required. For resident hunters, 1 bull can be taken with a Harvest Ticket and a valid 2024 Alaska hunting license. The season dates will be April 1, 2024 to April 14, 2024.
