

JOINT BOARD OF FISHERIES AND GAME Commissioner Nomination Meeting January 16, 2019, 7:00 p.m.

MEETING SUMMARY

The Joint Board of Game and Fisheries (Joint Board) met on January 16, 2019, to review and interview the candidate for the Commissioner of Alaska Department of Fish & Game to determine a list of names to forward to Governor Mike Dunleavy in accordance with Alaska Statute 44.39.030. The meeting was open to the public at the Sheraton Hotel in Anchorage, with the audio streamed online. Thirteen members of the boards were in attendance. Board of Game members Ted Spraker, Nate Turner, Tom Lamal, Stosh Hoffman, Karen Linnell, and Larry Van Daele attended via teleconference from Petersburg, Alaska. One Board of Game seat was vacant. Board of Fisheries members Israel Payton, Fritz Johnson, John Jensen, Robert Ruffner, Reed Morisky, Orville Huntington, and Al Cain participated in-person. Board of Fisheries chairman Morisky served as chair for the meeting.

The Joint Board reviewed the single application received by Boards Support Section during the recruitment process. The Joint Board determined to interview Doug Vincent-Lang. The Joint Board members asked Mr. Vincent-Lang a series of fish and game management policy questions. Upon conclusion of the interview with Mr. Vincent-Lang, the Joint Board agreed to forward his name to Governor Dunleavy as a qualified nomination for Commissioner.
