


Geographic Concentration



14 Aquatic Farms



Kachemak Bay Production




- 2013 total oyster production = 499,747 (sales = \$324K)
- 42% increase in production from 2012 to 2013

End-of-year Oyster Inventory



-Oyster inventory decreased from 3.8 million in 2012 to 2.8 million in 2013 (27%).

Acquired Seed



- New seed acquired decreased from 1.17 million in 2012 to 0.52 million in 2013 (56%).
- Decline in seed acquisition from 2009 to 2013.
- Proportion of new seed to inventory less in 2013 (19%) compared to 2012 (31%)

- Slow Growth
- Higher Mortality (range 30-50%)
- Winter Die-off
- Seed Shortage
