



Susitna Landing Boat Launch & Campground Rules

1. The use and discharge of FIREARMS is prohibited (Including PAINTBALL, BB, and ARCHERY equipment).
2. The use of off road and all-terrain vehicles is prohibited (ATV, Dirt Bikes, Side by Sides and UTV).
3. Vehicles are allowed only on established roads and parking areas.
4. Falling and cutting of trees is prohibited.
5. Littering is prohibited. Refuse may not be brought into the facility for disposal.
6. All unattended food and food containers must be secured in a hard-sided vehicle to prevent wildlife interactions.
7. Disturbing, damaging, or removing natural or cultural objects is prohibited; gathering berries, fruits, and mushrooms for personal consumption is permitted.
8. Pets must be leashed and under control at all times. Leashes are not to exceed 9 feet in length.
9. Fireworks are prohibited.
10. Peddling, soliciting, vending of any goods or services is not permitted.
11. The discharge of sewage, wastewater or gray water is prohibited except at the facility dump station.
12. Camping is permitted only in designated sites. Vehicles must fit in designated parking space and sleeping in vehicles constitutes camping.
13. Ground fires are prohibited. All fires must be attended to and contained within the provided fire ring or portable stove.
14. Ax and knife throwing is prohibited.
15. Campground quiet hours are from 11:00 pm to 6:00 am.
16. Checkout time is 12:00 pm (noon). Check-in time is 2:00 pm or as campsites are made available.
17. Campsites must be physically occupied the first night paid. Vehicles and campsites left unattended for more than 48 hours may be impounded.
18. Camping stay limit is 15 days. If the maximum stay limit is reached, all persons and property may not return to camp for 15 consecutive days.
19. Horses are not permitted in this area.
20. Fishing is not permitted in the boat launch or mooring lagoon.
21. Please do not throw or stack rocks in the boat launch or mooring lagoon.
22. No person may organize or conduct an assembly of more than 20 people in the public use facility unless authorized by a special area permit under 5 AAC 95
23. ALL Alaska State Park Passes are NOT honored at this facility.
