Rods

- Rod power: medium heavy to heavy, accommodating 15 to 30 pound test
- Action: moderate to fast action
- Desirable rod length between 6 to 8 feet <u>Reels</u>
- Level wind reel preferred
- Select a reel to balance the rod. If the rod accommodates 20 pound test, so should the reel.

Líne

- 15 to 30 pound test (depending on the rod and reel)
- Monofilament, braided, fluorocarbon
 Tackle
- Plugs: Hot Shot
- Pixee spoon (1/2-7/8 oz.)
- Vibrax Spinner (size 5-6)
- Tee spoon (size 9-13)
- Crippled Herring, Krocodile
- Hoochie squid
- Herring (medium or large) fished under a bobber
- Swivel (snap or lock)
