



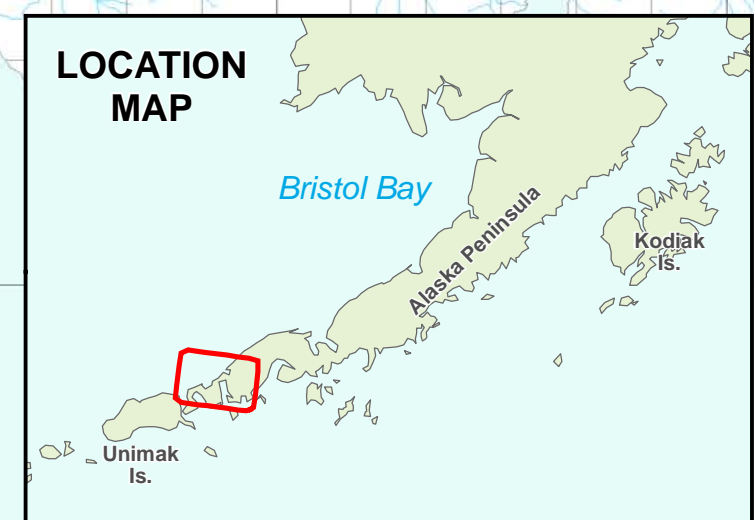
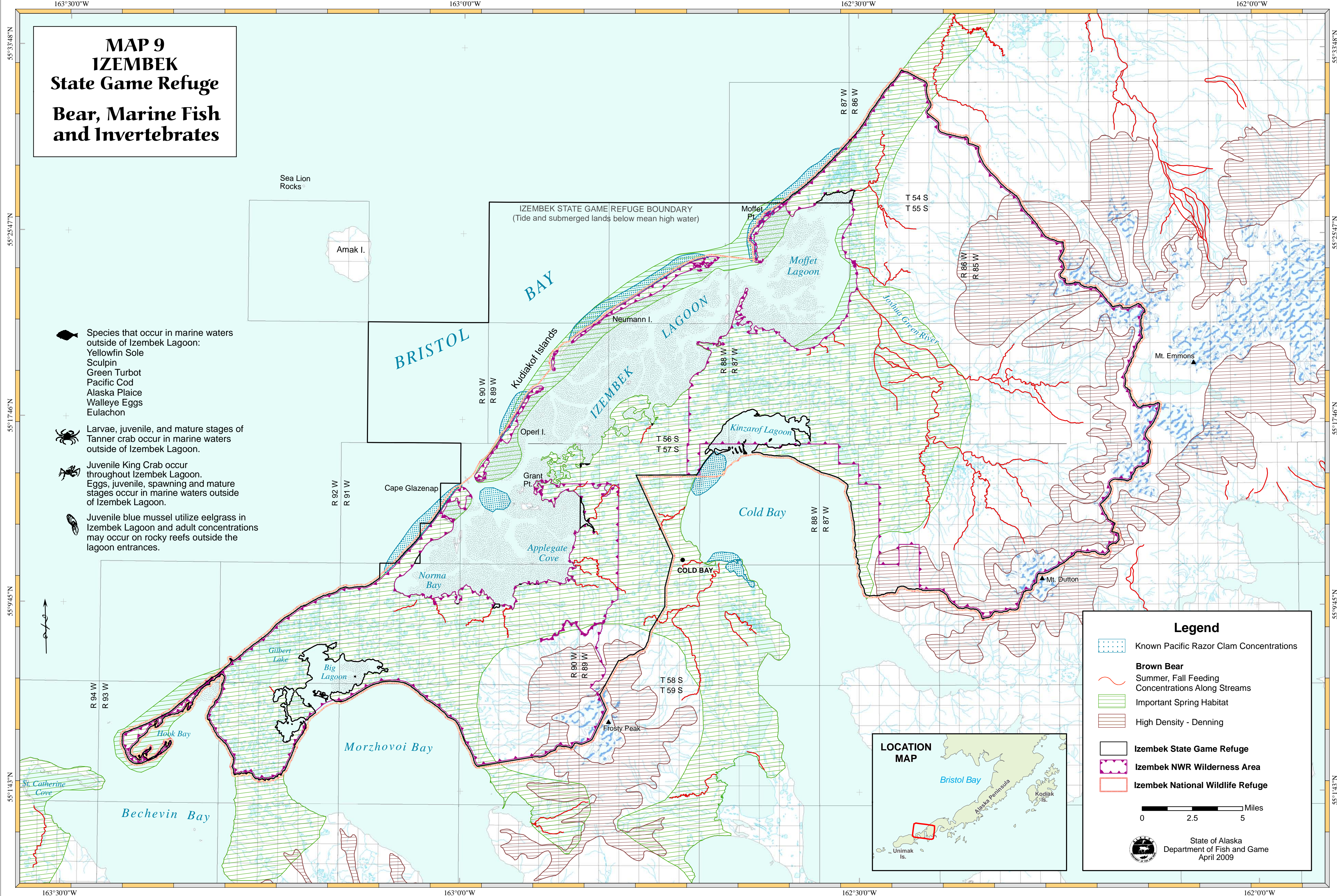
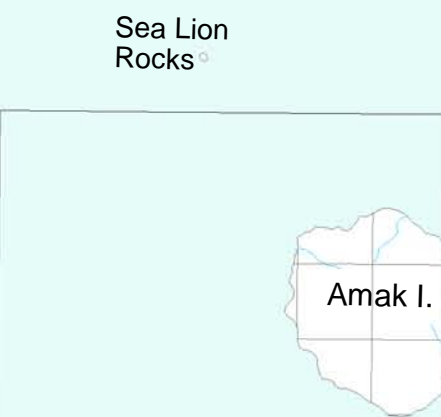









MAP 9 IZEMBEK State Game Refuge Bear, Marine Fish and Invertebrates

-  Species that occur in marine waters outside of Izembek Lagoon:
Yellowfin Sole
Sculpin
Green Turbot
Pacific Cod
Alaska Plaice
Walleye Eggs
Eulachon
-  Larvae, juvenile, and mature stages of Tanner crab occur in marine waters outside of Izembek Lagoon.
-  Juvenile King Crab occur throughout Izembek Lagoon. Eggs, juvenile, spawning and mature stages occur in marine waters outside of Izembek Lagoon.
-  Juvenile blue mussel utilize eelgrass in Izembek Lagoon and adult concentrations may occur on rocky reefs outside the lagoon entrances.
