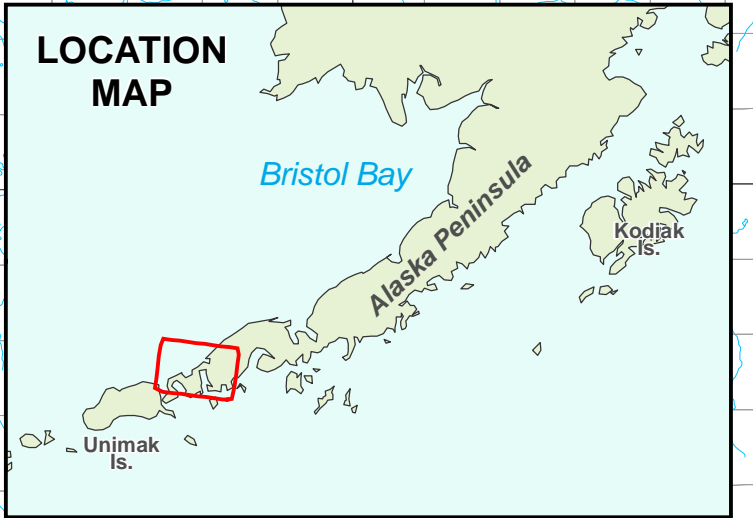

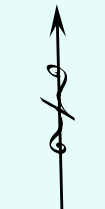

Shorebirds:
 Some species that do not flock (e.g., Pectoral sandpipers, sharp-tailed sandpipers) are missed by just looking for areas of high concentrations. Local breeders likely depend on food obtained in the lagoon to sustain them during egg-laying and chick rearing. Wintering shorebirds likely move around to take advantage of many ice-free areas. Spring use has fewer birds and is of shorter duration. Areas shown are peak use sites. Other areas are used also.
