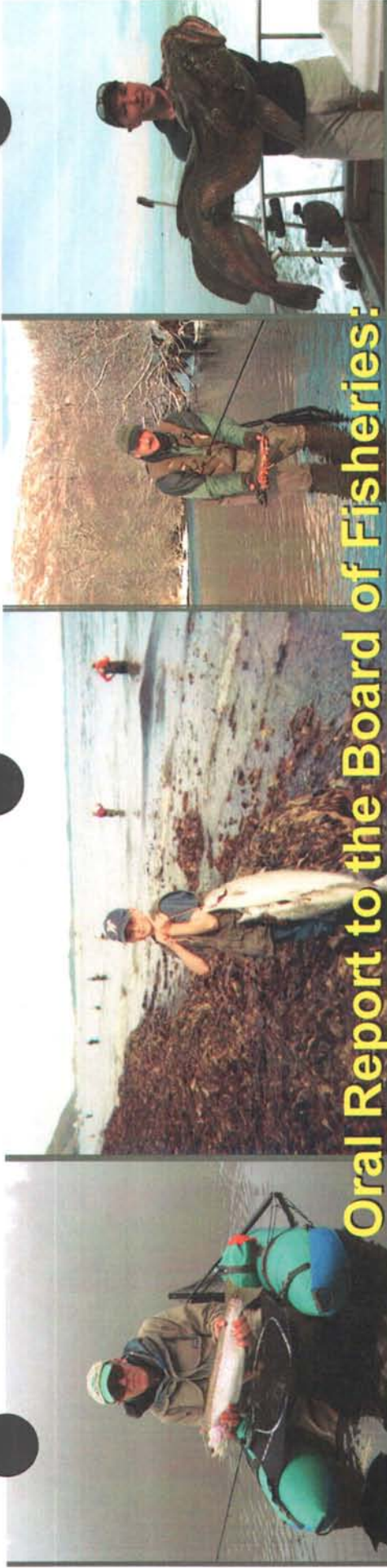
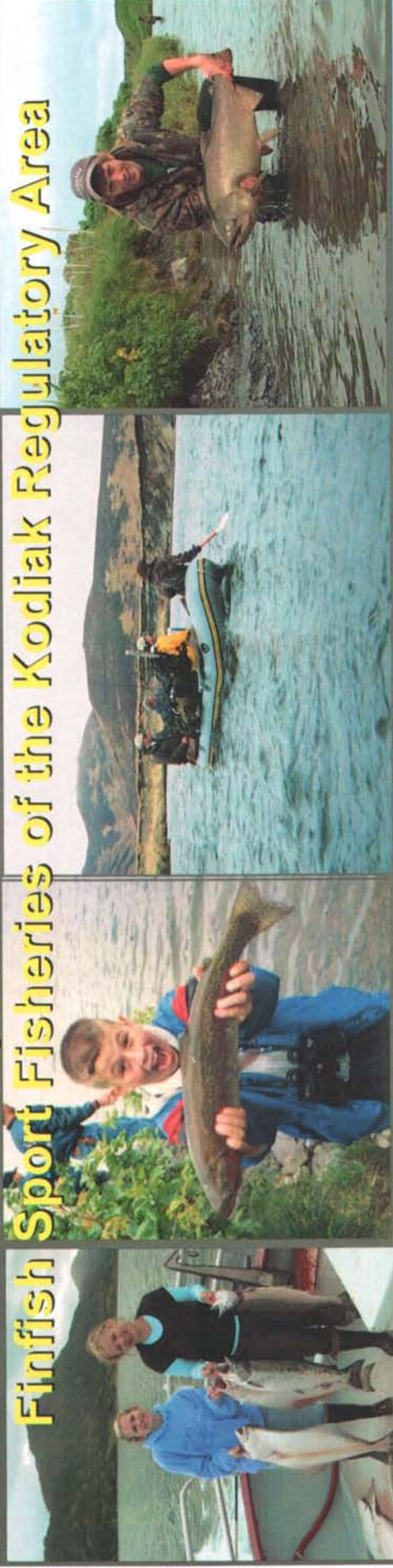

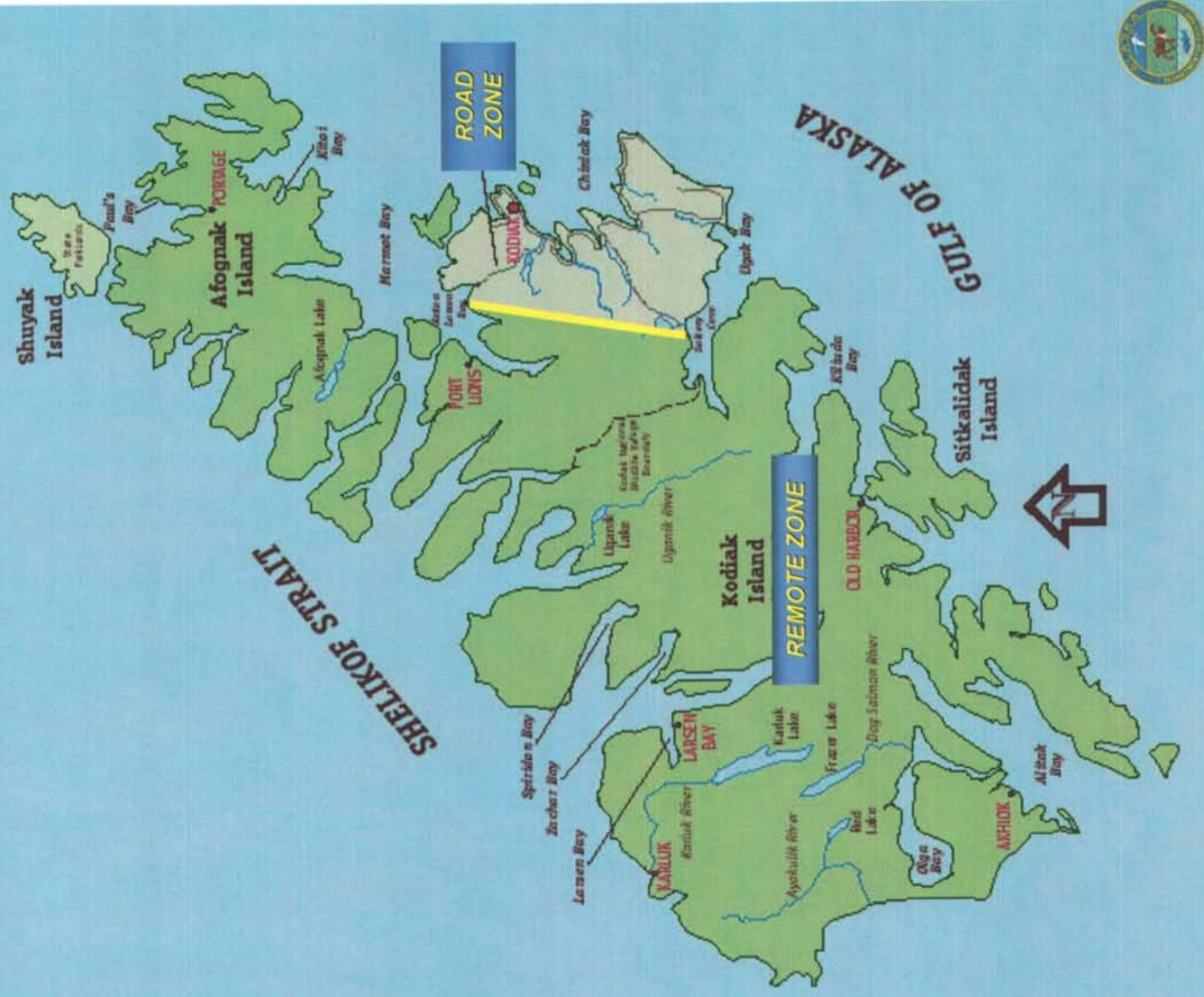

- Total of 13 KRA sport fishery proposals before the BOF



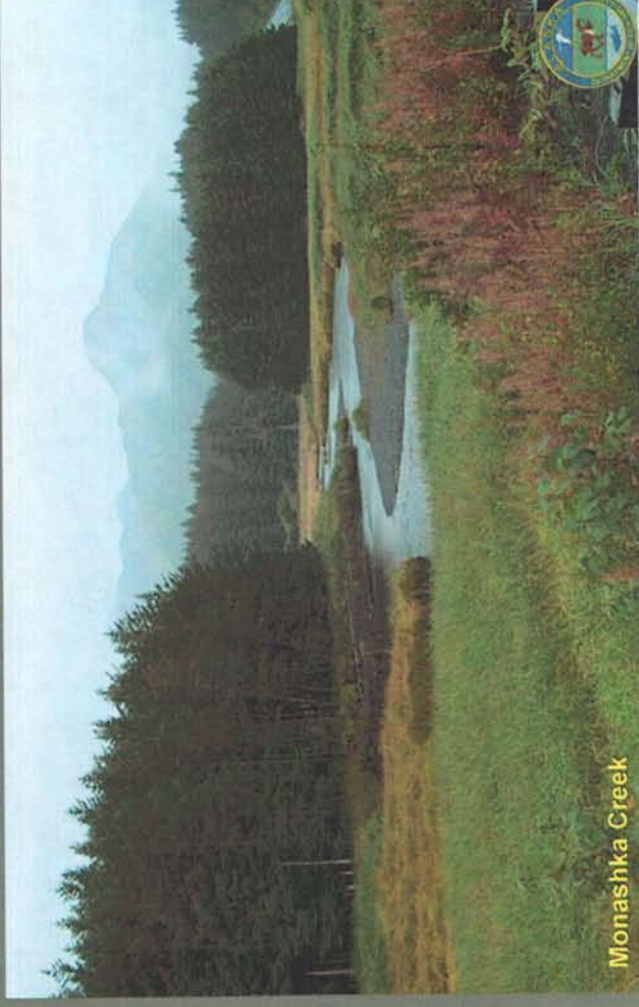
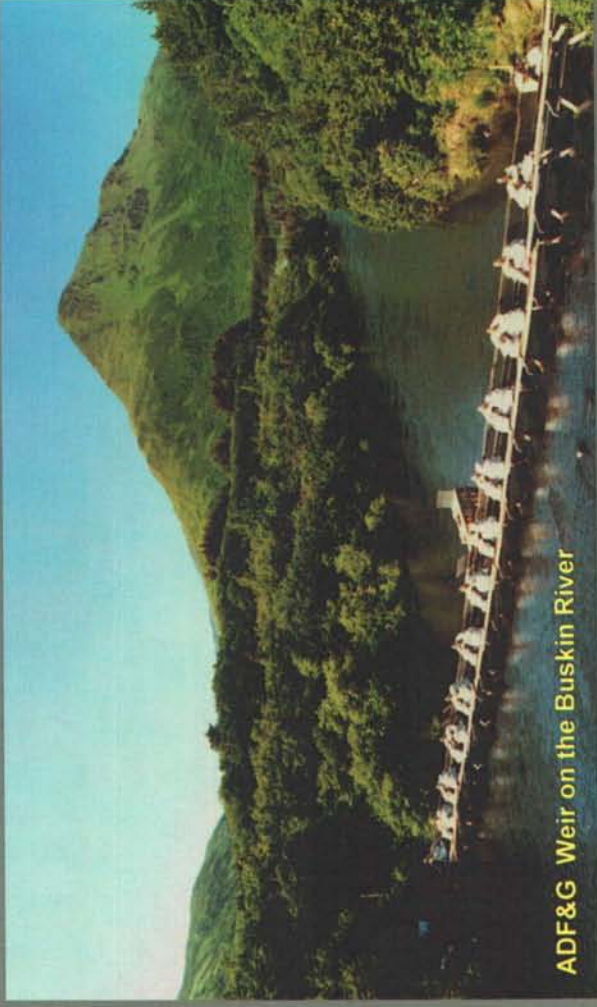
Kodiak Road Zone Sport Fishing Issues before the Board of Fisheries:

Proposal # 60

- Open entire Buskin River drainage to salmon fishing from Aug 1 – September 15

Proposal #'s 61 and 62

- Open Pillar Creek below the Monashka Highway to all sport fishing year round
- Close Pillar and Monashka Creeks above Monashka Highway to all sport fishing year round



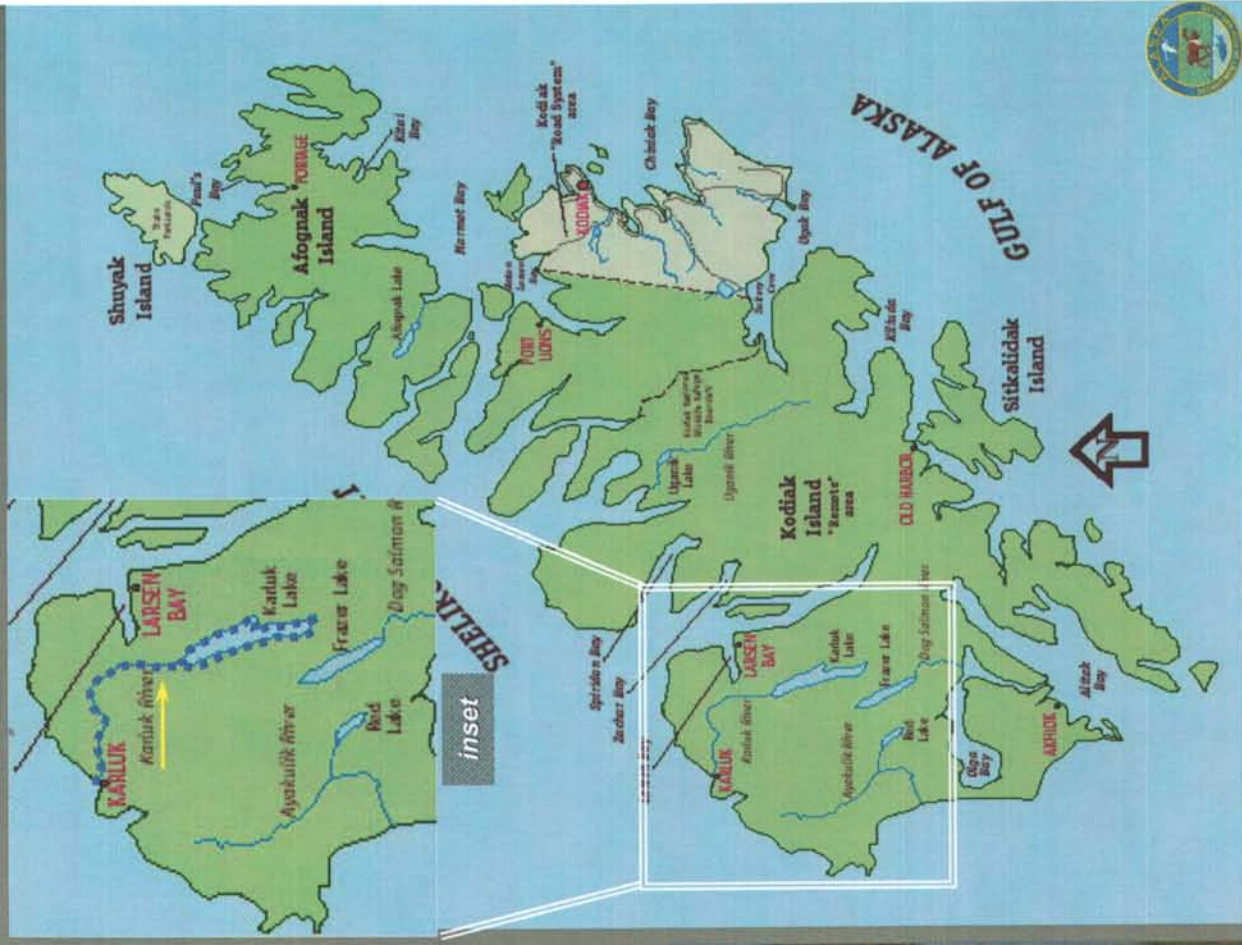
Kodiak Remote Zone Sport Fishing Issues before the Board of Fisheries:

- Prohibit use of bait on the Karluk River drainage below Karluk Lake from June 1 – July 25

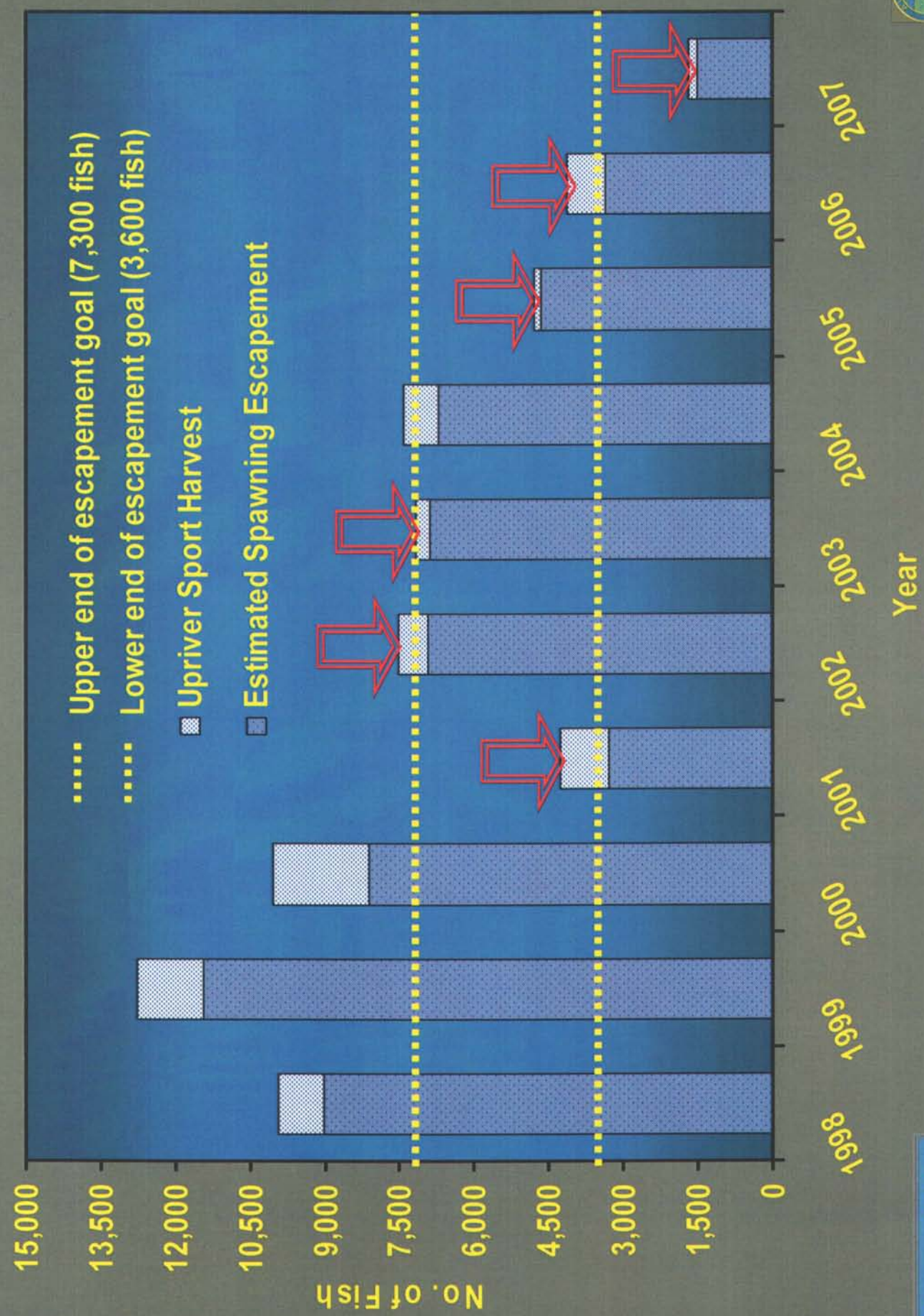


Karluk River Portage





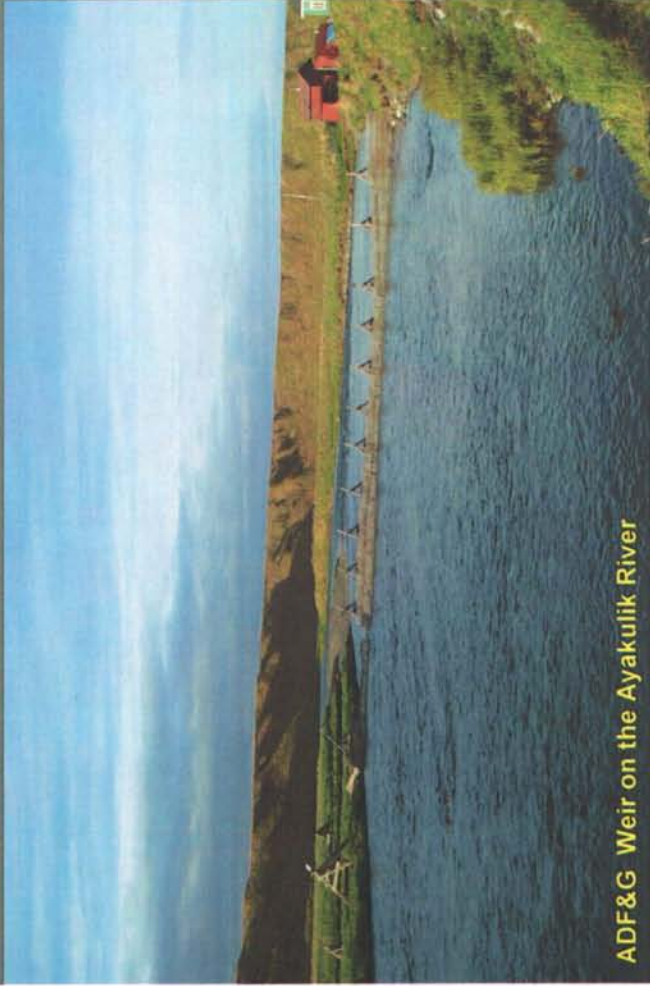
Karluk River King Salmon Upriver Sport Harvest and Estimated Spawning Escapement

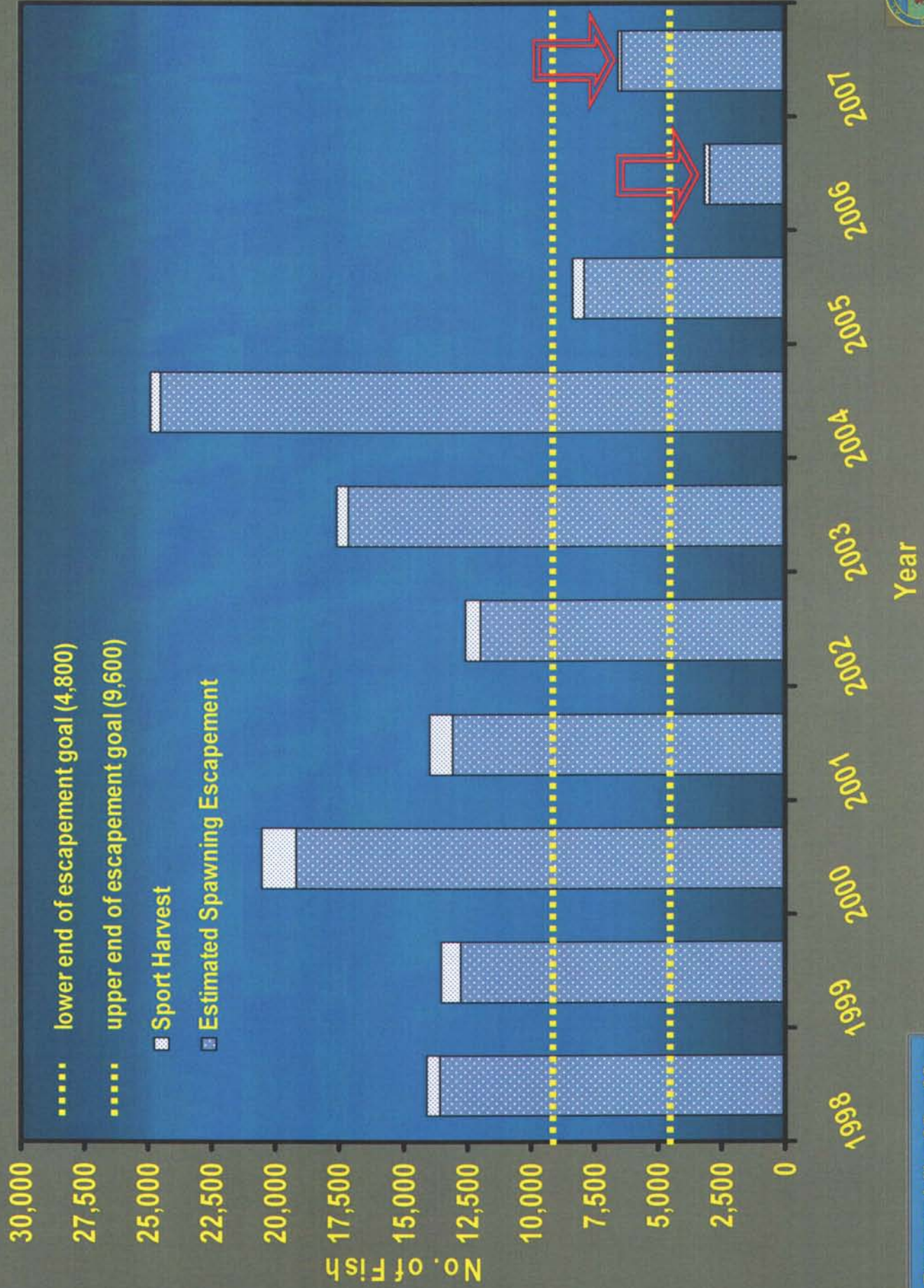
- Establish an Ayakulik River King Salmon OEG to allow catch and release below current escapement goal

Ayakulik River King Salmon Upriver Sport Harvest and Estimated Spawning Escapement



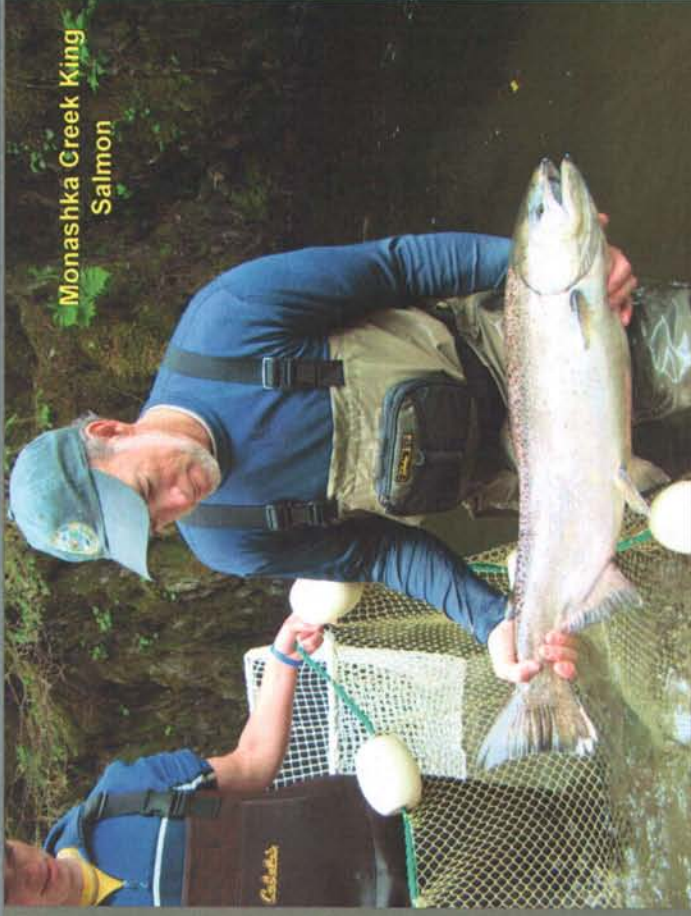
Kodiak Area Wide Sport Fishing Issues before the Board of Fisheries:

Proposal # 71

- Review the Kodiak Area Salt Water King Salmon Sport Fishery Management Plan (5 AAC 64.060.)

Major Provisions:

- Purpose of the plan to stabilize harvest with establishment of 8,000 fish GHL
- Daily bag and possession limit of 2 fish (no annual limit)
- If GHL is exceeded, Board will consider restrictions in the following order:
 - (1) reduce non-resident bag and possession limit to 1 fish;
 - (2) guides cannot take fish with clients onboard;
 - (3) minimum size limit of 28 inches;
 - (4) reduce resident bag and possession limit to 1 fish



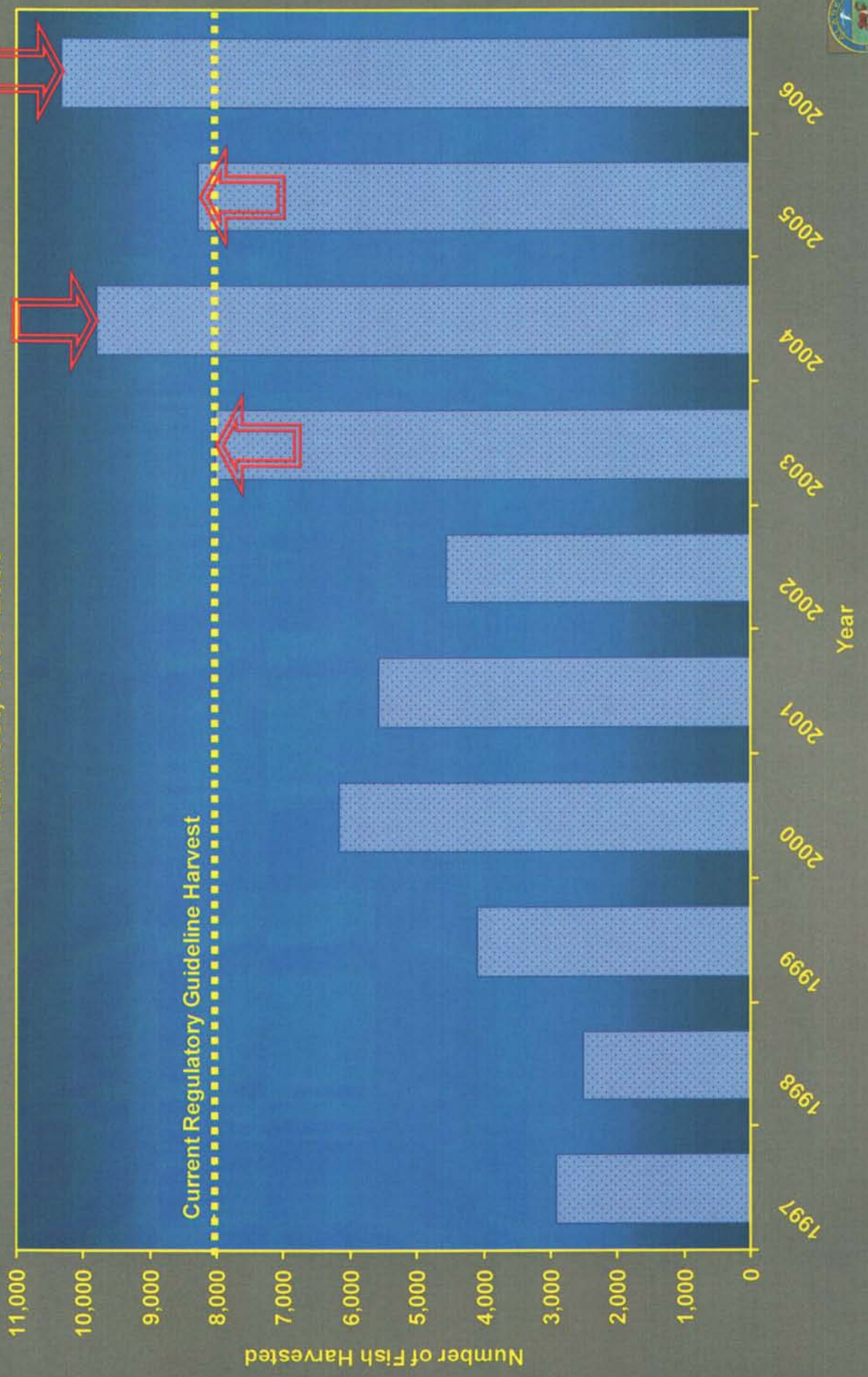
Monashka Creek King Salmon



Kodiak Saltwater King Salmon Catch

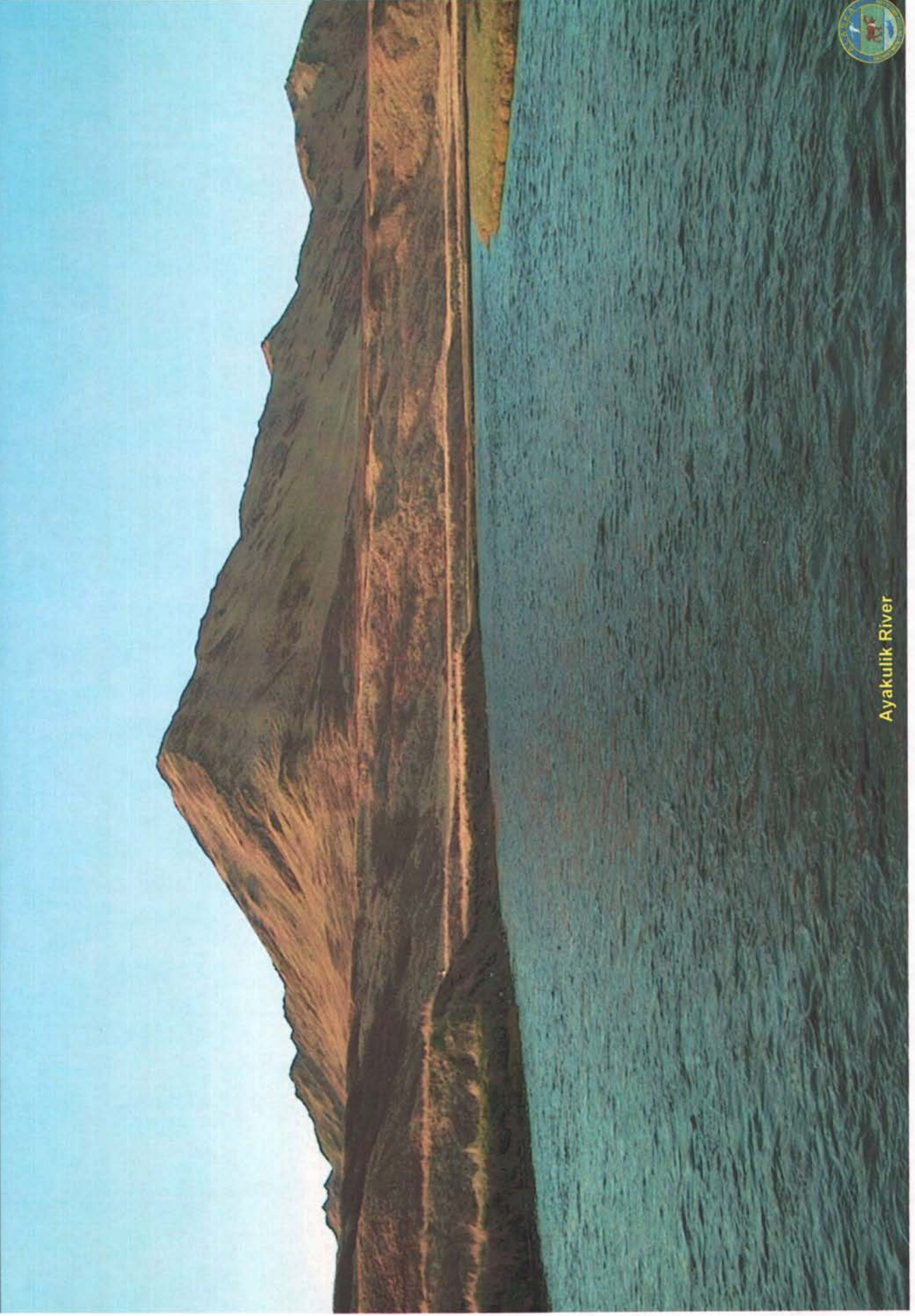


Kodiak Regulatory Area Estimated Saltwater King Salmon Sport Fishery Harvest, 1997-2006
