RKC Assessment / Management

Assessment

- Nine areas surveyed with ~560 pot lifts
- Biomass estimated using C-S model

Management plan


- Appropriate harvest rate
- Regional GHL set using survey biomass
- Pot limits based on GHL
- Minimum GHL threshold 200,000 pounds legal

Regulations

Males only, 7-inch minimum CW, November 1 season start

RKC Personal Use Management

Section 11-A Allocation Plan


- Personal use fishery: 60% of GHL
 - Summer (July 1–September 30): 50% of GHL
 - Winter (October 1–March 31): 10% of GHL
- Commercial fishery: 40% of GHL

Management guidelines

- Extend personal use fishery as long as possible, using
 - daily bag limits
 - number of pots/vessel
 - seasonal bag limit




Section 11-A Red King Crab Allocation Plan Areas


- Guideline harvest ranges for each of 7 fishing areas
- 100-pot per vessel limit

- Limited entry
- Males only
- Size limits
- Season start , February 10–17; concurrent w/ Tanner




Golden King Crab Management Areas

Assessment

- Six areas surveyed with ~293 pot lifts
- Biomass estimated using C-S model

Management plan


- Biomass-based threshold
- Season length determined by biomass and effort
- 80-pot vessel limit

Regulations

- Limited entry
- Males only
- Size limits
- Season start , February 10–17; concurrent w/ GKC




Major Commercial Tanner Crab Fishing Grounds

- Males only
- 6 1/2-inch minimum carapace width


- Limited entry
- Split season
 - Summer/Fall: June 15 Aug. 15, and Oct. 1 Nov. 30, or
 - Fall/Winter: Oct. 1 Feb. 28
- Tiered pot limits: 75, 150, 225, or 300
- Thresholds

Yakutat

- Open access
- Split season: Spring/Fall: May 15
 uly 14, and Nov. 1
 Feb. 28
- 400-pot vessel limit




Major Commercial Dungeness Crab Fishing Grounds






SE Dungeness Harvest / Effort

Yakutat Dungeness Harvest / Effort



Yakutat Dungeness crab harvest and effort, 1971/1972 through 1999/2000 commercial seasons. The fishery was closed beginning with the 2000/2001 season.
