
















Spiridon Bay Special Harvest Area (SBSHA) Sockeye Salmon

Westside Kodiak Proposals

- **Proposal 95** would open the Central Section on June 28 for one, set gillnet only, 114-hour fishing period
- Proposal 96 would open the inner bay sections of the Northwest Kodiak District to both gear types after August 15
- **Proposal 97** would delay closures in the Northwest Kodiak District based on National Weather Service forecasts of gale warnings
