Commissioner's Permit Requirements for Directed Walleye Pollock Harvest

- 1. Valid CFEC interim-use permit card for miscellaneous finfish is required (M26B, M26G, M05B, M05G).
- 2. Fishing may only occur within state waters (0 3 nm) of the Kodiak registration area for groundfish (Area K).
- **3.** Legal gear is mechanical jig machine and hand troll. A maximum of five lines may be operated with no more than 30 hooks per line.
- 4. Steller sea lion restrictions applicable during the Kodiak Area state-waters Pacific cod season apply.
- 5. Harvest of walleye pollock may not exceed 10,000 pounds per trip.
- 6. Total walleye pollock harvest by all permit holders will be capped at _____ pounds.
- 7. This permit will become valid upon opening of the Kodiak Area state-waters Pacific cod jig gear season, and will be invalidated upon closure of the Kodiak Area state-waters Pacific cod jig gear season, or when the total walleye pollock harvest cap is reached, whichever occurs first.
- 8. Bycatch of black rockfish is limited to 20% by weight of walleye pollock onboard the vessel.
- 9. The department may implement additional reporting requirements to improve management precision.
- **10.** Failure to comply with the stipulations specified above will result in revocation of this commissioner's permit.
