The Juneau-Douglas AC met on 12/19 with 11 committee members in attendance, one of which was via teleconference. The AC discussed BOG and Shellfish proposals. ADF&G personnel present included Stephanie Sell - WC AMB, Dave Harris - CF AMB, Adam Messmer - Region 1 crab biologist, and David Love - SF AAMB. BOG proposals 12-18, 23,26-29,31,35 and 38 were discussed with Stephanie Sell for the majority of the meeting. Adam Messmer then fielded questions about shellfish proposals, Dave Harris talked about commercial fish proposals, and I discussed the proposal about the permit requirement for sport and personal use shrimp in 11-A.

Finfish proposals were scheduled for Monday, January 5 at 6 PM at the Egan Library on the UAS Campus.
