
Southeast Alaska Commercial Dungeness Crab Management

- Size, sex and season
 - Males only
 - 6 1/2-inch minimum carapace width
- Limited entry 279 permits
- Tiered pot limits: 75, 150, 225, or 300
- Management plan Harvest projection threshold


Southeast Alaska

Commercial Dungeness crab seasons.

- Split season
 - Summer: June 15–Aug. 15
 - Fall/Winter: Oct. 1–Nov. 30 or Oct. 1–Feb. 28




Southeast Commercial Dungeness Crab Harvest / Effort



Southeast Alaska Dungeness crab harvest and effort, 1971/1972 through 2014/2015 (harvest through November 30, 2014) commercial seasons.


Southeast Commercial Dungeness Crab Ex-vessel Value / CPUE (1985/1986 – 2014/2015 Seasons)



- Proposals 69-79: Dungeness closed waters.


Southeast Alaska Management Plan

Harvest Projection Threshold

- Simple regression to predict the current season's catch
 - Based on catch and effort in first seven days
- Based on three variables: •
 - 1. First seven days landed poundage.
 - 2. Number of permits that made landings in the first seven days.
 - **3.** Relationship between catch for the first seven days of the previous season to total catch for the previous season expressed as a decimal fraction.

 $\frac{7 \text{ day catch (lbs)}}{\text{season catch (lbs)}} = \text{ratio of 7 day catch to total season catch (lbs)}$

Season lengths based on projection

Season	<1.50 million lb	Between 1.50 and 2.25 million lb	>2.25 million lb
Summer	Closes <u>no sooner</u> than 21 days after season opening.	Closes <u>no sooner</u> than 28 days after season opening.	Complete season.
Fall	No fall season.	30 day fall season.	Complete season.

 5 AAC 32.146 (3) states that if the department determines that harvest projections fail to meet threshold due to soft-shelled crabs early in the commercial Dungeness crab summer fishing season, the department may open the commercial Dungeness crab fall fishing season for the standard duration.
