I can recall that the fish were plentiful and we wanted for nothing. This was back in the 1940's. We lived a very independent lifestyle and depended on no one. There was no welfare, Unemployment or social ills we suffer today.

As secretary of ANB we support our subsistence lifestyle, embrace our cultural Values, and defend our subsistence rights as the first peoples of Alaska.

For the next ten thousand years, may there be native foods for our future Generations, wheather they be of any race.
