Being in the mud flat area and having the seaward distance of 500 feet has been a challenge, as the years have passed and the mudflat has seen dramatic change in length and been filled in it has caused my family to lose valuable fishing time. This loss of fishing time is worsened when tides are smaller then 16 feet we are unable to set due to tides being too small. While the sites located above the Clarks Point bluff remain unaffected and continue to fish and earn an income.

I'm in support of extension of the seaward distance for the set netters along the bluff from 500 to 750 feet, as I believe this will ensure that my family and I would be allowed enough water to fish and help stop the loss of income.

My family greatly depends on income earned from the commercial fishing season and this extension will offer an opportunity to continue fishing during these smaller tides. With the declining fish price my family and I have been impacted greatly financially and I can't stress enough what this extension means to me.
