5 AAC 39.260. Seine specifications and operations is amended to read:

• • •

(c) A purse seine has stopped fishing when both ends of the seine, excluding skiff tow lines and straps, are attached to the seine vessel [UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN 5 AAC 03 – 5 AAC 38, A PURSE SEINE IS CONSIDERED TO HAVE CEASED FISHING WHEN ALL THE RINGS ARE OUT OF THE WATER].

...

(j) A seine vessel must be attached to one end, and only one end, of a purse seine or lead when it is in operation. Any line used to make the attachment may not be more than 13 [10] fathoms in length.
