Proposal 166 A

5 AAC 92.013 Migratory bird hunting guide services

Amend to create a new definition under 5 AAC 92.013: "Migratory Bird transport services" means a business or affiliated business, that assists hunters; or migratory Bird hunting Guides to transport hunters; by personally directing hunters in hunting activities; assisting in the carriage of hunters, their equipment; or migratory birds harvested by hunters to, from, or in the field; for compensation by water taxi, air taxi, fishing charter outfitters; combo hunting/fishing boats; or lodges.

Many business entities guide, transport waterfowl hunters or assist with the registered Migratory Bird Guide Services. These entities are not registered with the Department so information is not captured of their existence as additional Migratory Bird Guides. This skews harvest data.
