
The board will meet in-person at the Anchorage Sheraton Hotel, in the Howard Rock Ballroom, 401 E. 6th Avenue Anchorage, Alaska, beginning at 7:00 p.m. The board is expected to review applicant information and may choose to interview the applicant at the meeting. The board will not take public comment during the meeting. The listen-in only site is at the meeting room at the Sheraton Hotel. Members from Board of Game intend to participate at the meeting in-person after traveling from a meeting in Petersburg. At the meeting, the board may go into executive session to discuss matters permitted in AS 44.62.310(c), namely personnel matters under section (c)(2) and to discuss personal attributes of the candidates. The public is excluded from the executive session.
