EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the State of Alaska resident and nonresident mountain goat registration permit hunt RG230 (McKinley-Saddlebag) in Game Management Unit 6(C). Mountain goat hunting regulations in all other portions of Game Management Unit 6 are not affected by this emergency order.

REGULATION:


Therefore, the following regulations in 5AAC 85.040(a)(2), **Hunting Seasons and Bag Limits for Goat**, are superseded by this emergency order and the following provisions are effective:

Units and Bag Limits	Resident Open Season (Subsistence and General Hunts)	Nonresident Open Season
(2) Unit 6(C), Hunt RG230: specifically, that portion of Unit 6(C) east of Sheridan Glacier and the main channel of Glacier River, and north of the Copper River Highway.	Oct. 7 – Oct. 20	Oct. 7 – Oct. 20

1 goat by registration permit only.

All other mountain goat hunting regulations in Unit 6 are not affected by this emergency order

JUSTIFICATION:

Aerial surveys completed recently yielded a count of 170 goats in registration permit area RG230. Maximum allowable harvest this year under the State of Alaska hunt was set at 8 goats. Reported harvest is now 4 billies and 2 nannies. Nannies count as 2 goats in the harvest. Any additional take could harm stability of the population.
