## **Mulchatna Caribou Herd update will be included March 15 at the Board of Game meeting in Fairbanks**

(Juneau) – Wildlife Biologist Tom Paragi will present a recently authored white paper on the Mulchatna Caribou Herd, “Review of Factors in Public and Agency Predator Control for Mulchatna Caribou, 2012-2023,” at the upcoming Board of Game regulatory meeting in Fairbanks.

Paragi is the first presenter on the schedule, following opening business, and his presentation should begin about 9:30, Friday, March 15.
