

RESOLUTION OF THE ALASKA BOARD OF GAME

WHEREAS, the Alaska Board of Game is charged with the conservation and development of the wildlife resources of the state; and


WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Fish and Game has identified a weather related conservation problem with deer in Game Management Unit 4,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the Alaska Board of Game finds that, due to excessive mortality resulting from severe winter conditions in parts of Game Management Unit 4, portions of the deer populations in Unit 4 have been reduced substantially to the point where future hunting opportunities may be significantly impacted, and accordingly

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Alaska Board of Game endorses and supports the emergency closure for deer in Game Management Unit 4 by the Alaska Department of Fish and Game in order to protect the deer populations (copy attached), and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Alaska Board of Game requests that the U. S. Forest Service and the Federal Subsistence Board take immediate action to protect the deer populations in Game Management Unit 4.
