### EXPLANATION:

This emergency order establishes a bag and possession limit of four king salmon for the fresh waters of Glacier, Moraine, and Crystal lakes located within the Mendenhall Glacier Recreation Area in Juneau.

### REGULATION:

This emergency order adds the provisions of 5 AAC 47.023(e)(1)(L). These provisions are effective from 12:01 a.m. Friday May 27, 2011 through Saturday, December 31, 2011 and are as follows:

### **5 AAC 47.023. Special provisions for seasons, bag, possession, and size limits, and methods and means for the fresh waters of the Southeast Alaska Area.**

(e) In the Juneau vicinity:

(1) in all drainages crossed by the Juneau City and Borough road system,

(L) in Glacier Lake, Moraine Lake, and Crystal Lake, the bag and possession limit is four king salmon.

### JUSTIFICATION

The Alaska Board of Fisheries authorized the department to use its emergency order authority to increase sport bag and possession limits for hatchery-produced fish when there are no other competing user groups. One thousand five hundred sub-catchable hatchery produced king salmon were stocked into Glacier, Moraine, and Crystal lakes in late October 2010 to provide additional sport fishing opportunity in 2011. Therefore, the department is establishing a bag and possession limit of four king salmon for these waters.
