Alaska Department of Fish & Game, Division of Sport Fish Announces 2012 Sport Fishing Regulations Booklet Photo Contest

The Alaska Department of Fish and Game is now accepting photo entries for the *2012 Sport Fishing Regulations Summary* photo contest. Four images will be selected, one from each regulatory area, and each will appear on the cover of the corresponding *2012 Sport Fishing Regulations Summary booklet*. The deadline for submissions is 5 p.m., November 1, 2011.

Regulatory areas include:

- Arctic-Yukon-Kuskokwim/Upper Copper-Upper Susitna
- Southcentral Alaska
- Bristol Bay Drainages
- Kodiak Island, Alaska Peninsula, Aleutian Islands

Photos should feature one or more youths engaged in sport fishing, or sport fishing activities in Alaska. The primary person in the photo must be under the age of 18 when the photo was taken. Photos that include advertisements or show evidence of fish and game violations or people acting in an unethical or unsafe manner will be disqualified from consideration.

Send photos to dfg.dsf.AquaticEd@alaska.gov. The subject line of the e-mail must include the name of the water body or drainage in which the photo was taken. Digital photos must be less than 10MB, but should be of a resolution as to present a clear, crisp image when scaled to 8.5" x 11".

A maximum of three photos may be entered per photographer.
 With submissions, please include:

- The name and age of the main subject(s)
- The name and contact information of the person who took the photo
- The name and contact information of the main subjects' parent or guardian
- A brief description of the fishing adventure (what, when, where)
