EXPLANATION:

This emergency order increases the bag and possession limit for sockeye salmon to 10 fish in the SALTERY Cove drainage.

REGULATION:

The provisions of 5 AAC 64.022 Waters; seasons; bag, possession, annual, and size limits; and special provisions for the Kodiak Area. (b)(5) are superseded by this emergency order. Under this emergency order the following provisions are effective beginning 12:01 a.m. Wednesday, July 6, 2016.

5 AAC 64.022. Waters; seasons; bag, possession, annual, and size limits; and special provisions for the Kodiak Area.

(b)(5) in the SALTERY Cove drainage, the bag and possession limit for salmon, other than king salmon, is 10 fish, of which, no more than five per day and in possession may be pink and chum salmon, and two per day and in possession may be coho salmon.

JUSTIFICATION:

The escapement goal for sockeye salmon into the Saltery Cove drainage is 15,000 to 35,000 fish. As of July 4, the weir count was 12,537 sockeye salmon. Based on historical run timing, the department is projecting the escapement goal will be exceeded. To provide additional sport fishing opportunity to harvest sockeye salmon surplus to the escapement goal, as authorized in 5 AAC 75.003 (2)(A), increasing the limit in the Saltery Cove drainage is warranted.
