EXPLANATION: This emergency order rescinds Emergency Order No. 1-KS-E-17-18 that was issued in Juneau on Monday, June 25, 2018 that closed king salmon sport fishing and snagging in the marine waters near Douglas Island Pink and Chum Inc., Macaulay Salmon Hatchery. King salmon regulations in the area will revert to the provisions outlined in Emergency Order No. 1-KS-E-13-18 which establishes a bag and possession limit of two king salmon of any size through August 31. King salmon harvested in this area do not count toward the nonresident annual limit.

REGULATION: Emergency Order No. 1-KS-E-17-18 is rescinded.
