## **EXPLANATION:**

This emergency order closes the personal use dip net salmon fishery in the Chitina Subdistrict of the Upper Copper River District for the week of July 27 – August 2.

## **REGULATION:**

Consistent with 5 AAC 77.001(b) and 5 AAC 77.591 Copper River Personal Use Dip Net Salmon Fishery Management Plan and authority under AS 16.05.060, the personal use dip net salmon fishery in the Chitina Subdistrict of the Upper Copper River District will be closed from 12:01 a.m. Monday, July 27 through 11:59 p.m. Sunday, August 2, 2020.

#### **JUSTIFICATION:**

The Copper River personal use fishery is managed under the *Copper River Personal Use Dip Net Salmon Fishery Management Plan* (5 AAC 77.591) and directs the department to establish weekly fishing periods based on Miles Lake sonar counts. During July 13 – 19, there were 41,777 salmon counted past the sonar with an objective of 47,737 salmon, a deficit of 5,960 salmon for the week. This level of sonar passage would normally allow for 84 hours of fishing time during the week of July 27 – August 2. However, total salmon passage by the Miles Lake sonar is 11% below the inriver goal objective for this date. As of July 21, a total of 521,678 salmon have been counted past the Miles Lake sonar compared to an objective of 586,593 salmon for this date, a deficit of 64,915 salmon with over 85% of the run past the sonar. Due to overall low sockeye salmon passage and concerns of not achieving the sockeye salmon escapement goal, a full closure of the Chitina Subdistrict personal use salmon dip net fishery for the week of July 27 – August 2 is justified.
