EXPLANATION:

This emergency order rescinds Emergency Order 2-RS-2-52-21 which closed sport fishing on Larson Creek and within a one-quarter mile radius of its confluence with the Talkeetna River to sport fishing for all salmon. Beginning 6:00 a.m. Saturday, August 14 through 11:59 p.m. Friday, December 31, 2021, the retention of salmon, other than king salmon, is allowed in Larson Creek and within one-quarter mile radius of its confluence with the Talkeetna River.

REGULATION:

Emergency Order No. 2-RS-2-52-21 is rescinded.

JUSTIFICATION:

The sustainable escapement goal for sockeye salmon in Larson Creek is 15,000 - 35,000 fish. As of Thursday morning, August 12, 2021, a total of 13,033 fish have passed the weir and the SEG is projected to be achieved. The anticipated harvest from this action is not expected to reduce the spawning escapement below the SEG and all harvest takes place downstream of the weir.

OTHER EMERGENCY ORDERS AFFECTED:

Emergency Order 2-RS-2-52-21 issued August 2, 2021, closed sport fishing on Larson Creek and within a one-quarter mile radius of its confluence with the Talkeetna River to sport fishing for all salmon.
