EXPLANATION:

This emergency order increases the pink salmon bag and possession limit in the salt waters of Port Valdez north of a line from Potato Point to Entrance Point (Valdez Narrows) to 12 fish per day and 24 in possession. Fresh water salmon closures remain in effect for Port Valdez.

REGULATION:

The provisions of 5 AAC 55.023. (1)(B)(ii) are superseded by this emergency order. Under this emergency order, the following provisions are effective 12:01 a.m. Friday, July 15 through 11:59 p.m. Saturday, December 31, 2022:

5 AAC 55.023. Special provisions for seasons, bag, possession, and size limits, and methods and means in the Prince William Sound area.

(1) the following special provisions apply to salmon, other than king salmon:

(B) within the following terminal harvest areas, the bag limit is six fish; and the possession limit is 12 fish:

(ii) Valdez Vicinity: the salt waters north of a line from Point Freemantle to Rocky Point, excluding Jack Bay, Sawmill Bay, and Galena Bay; except that in all salt waters north of a line from Potato Point to Entrance Point, the bag limit for pink salmon is 12 fish; and possession limit is 24 fish;

JUSTIFICATION:

As provided in 5 AAC 75.003. (2)(B), the department may use emergency order authority to increase sport fish bag and possession limits when hatchery-produced fish escape through existing fisheries to designated harvest areas in numbers that exceed broodstock needs or any natural spawning requirements. The pink salmon run to the Valdez Fisheries Development Association Solomon Gulch Hatchery are anticipated to meet broodstock needs and cost recovery goals have been met. There are no wild stock concerns that will occur due to the increased bag limits, and it is warranted to increase the pink salmon bag and possession limits in the Port Valdez marine waters for these surplus hatchery fish.
