



WHAT:



Combining biological information with traditional and Indigenous knowledge from these meetings to more deeply understand salmon in the Kuskokwim River.











Total Harvest of Kuskokwim river salmon




Harvest of Chinook salmon in the Kuskokwim River



Harvest of Chum salmon in the Kuskokwim River




Harvest of Sockeye salmon in the Kuskokwim River




Harvest of Coho salmon in the Kuskokwim River




Historical subsistence harvest estimates of Chinook salmon in the Kuskokwim River by sub-area.
