June 2, 2021

This meeting of the Kuskokwim River Salmon Management Working Group was called to order at approximately 10:05 a.m. and adjourned at approximately 12:15 p.m. A quorum was established with seven full voting members present. Alissa Rodgers and LaMont Albertson chaired the meeting.

AGENDA ITEMS

- A. USFWS/KRITFC UPDATE: Audio for this update begins at 20:40 Meeting Audio 06/02/21
 - a. Boyd Blihovde (USFWS) gave a brief update and spoke of some of the programs that are currently in place such as the KYUK Fish Talk and other meetings being had to keep the public informed.
 - **b.** Mary Peltola (2nd Member At Large; KRITFC) gave a brief update about happenings at the KRITFC. There was an annual meeting at the beginning of April and elections occurred.
- **B.** ADF&G MANAGEMENT ACTIONS UNDER CONSIDERATION: Audio begins at 29:01 Meeting Audio 06/02/21
 - **a.** Nick Smith (ADF&G) informed the Working Group that the implementation of subsistence harvest permits in sections 4 and 5 was under consideration.
- C. PEOPLE TO BE HEARD: Non-Working Group Members
 - a. There were no people to be heard for this meeting.
- **D.** CONTINUING BUSINESS: Audio for subsistence reports begins at 31:40 Meeting Audio 06/02/21
 - Subsistence Reports: Lowest River, ONC Inseason Subsistence Report, Lower River, Middle River, Upper River, Headwaters
 - Lower River Reports
 - John Andrew (Kwethluk; Downriver Elder / YK Delta RAC) said that smelt fishing had been good near Kwethluk. Prior to the frontend closure there had been mostly sheefish caught with only a few kings harvested. Fishing for pike and whitefish had been tough due to high water.
 - Mary Peltola (Bethel; 2nd Member at Large) had not caught any fish yet but only drifted a couple of times. She informed the group that there was a very large snag in the Bethel Test Fish drifting zone and for people to be aware of that while fishing there.
 - Charles Guest (Bethel; Commercial Fishing) had heard of a couple kings being caught near Napaskiak on May 29 and 30, but mostly sheefish had been caught. He said that the water has been high and full of debris.
 - James Nicori (Kwethluk; KRITFC) said that he was mostly catching sheefish but had caught a couple smaller kings on May 31.
 - Alissa Rodgers (Bethel; Lower River Subsistence) said that she had not been out yet due to boat work but had heard that kings had been caught near Tuntutuliak, Bethel, and Kwethluk using either set or drift gillnets.
 - Mike Williams (Akiak; Lower River Subsistence) said that people were catching some sheefish, broad whitefish, and pike up until May 31st with setnets. Some drifting was done on May 31st and a few jack kings were caught.
 - o ONC Inseason Subsistence Report
 - Danielle Lowery (ONC) informed the group that as of June 2 ONC would begin harvest surveys at area fish camps and at the boat harbor. ONC will provide a report of those surveys at the June 9 meeting. ONC has delivered 2 king salmon and 4 sheefish (caught at BTF) to elders in Bethel.
 - o Middle River
 - LaMont Albertson (Sportfishing) remarked that water was high in the middle river and that people were catching some pike and sheefish.
 - Dan Gillikin (Aniak) said that there was not much fishing activity yet and no salmon caught. The
 water levels were still high and some people were catching some large broad whitefish.

 - Kevin Whitworth (McGrath, Western Interior RAC) said that fishing was slow so far. The water has been coming down in the river but was still high and murky in the creeks and lakes.

 - o Test Fisheries (Bethel and Aniak):
 - Sean Larson (ADF&G) informed the group that BTF officially started operations on June 1 and had not yet caught a king.
 - Dan Gillikin (NVN) informed the group that ATF had started and that nothing had been caught yet. He said that the high water was influencing catch effort.
 - Sonar/Weirs/Aerial Surveys/Other:
 - Sean Larson (ADF&G) let the group know that the sonar was operational, and that test
 fishing had begun. He stated that the weirs would not be installed for another couple of
 weeks.
 - Frank Harris (USFWS) let the group know that the Kwethluk River weir will be operating this year. Aaron Moses (USFWS) informed the group that survey flights would be occurring during openers to count nets.
 - o NVN Report: See information above from Dan Gillikin.
- Working Group KRITFC Representative Report
 - o LaMont Albertson stated there was nothing to report at this time.
- Trawl Bycatch Report
