Proposals from Unalaska/Dutch Harbor AC meeting held

September 17, 2011 in Unalaska, Alaska

- A. **Proposal 18** under Amend 5 AAC 28.577. South Alaska Peninsula Area Pacific Cod Management Plan vessels transferring from Area O must stand down for seven days. No motion made to support.
- B. **Proposal 19** under 5AAC 28.577. South Alaska Peninsula Area Pacific Cod Management Plan. Develop regulations governing the state water Pacific Cod fisheries to address federal/parallel Gulf of Alaska gear sector allocations. No motion made to support.
- C. **Proposal 20** under 5AAC 28.577. South Alaska Peninsula Area Pacific Cod Management Plan. Open state-waters Pacific Cod season seven days after the federal Western Gulf of Alaska A season Pacific Cod pot sector closes. No motion made to support.
- D. **Proposal 21** 5AAC 28.577. South Alaska Peninsula Area Pacific Cod Management Plan. Open state-water Pacific Cod season on March 1st or seven days after federal Gulf of Alaska Pacific Cod pot cod sector closes, whichever is later. Discussion, pot cod harvesters from Unalaska area felt a later opening would be beneficial for allowing there participation in the fishery. Motion to support proposal 21 by Zac Nehus second by Roger Rowland motion to support passes 7-0.
- E. **Proposal 22** 5AAC 28.577. South Alaska Peninsula Area Pacific Cod Management Plan. Open state-water Pacific cod season on March 15, or seven days after federal Western Gulf of Alaska cod sector closes if that closure is later than March 15. No motion made to support.
- F. **Proposals 23-31** 5AAC 28.577 South Alaska Peninsula Area Pacific Cod Management Plan. These proposals all have to do with various increases to the jig gear allocation in the South Alaska Peninsula Area Pacific Cod fishery. Discussion, committee felt increases to the jig sector would adversely impact other Pacific cod harvesters that use other gear types, it

should be noted that this fishery is already fully utilized. Motion to support by Roger Rowland second by Don Goodfellow motion fails 7-0.

- G. **Proposal 32-** 5AAC 28.570. Lawful Gear for South Alaska Peninsula Area. Repeal one definition of mechanical jigging machine gear as follows a single continuous line with no more than 150 hooks. Motion to support Roger Rowland second by Don Goodfellow. Discussion, housekeeping issue from ADFG, committee had no problem supporting the department, motion to support passed 7-0.
- H. **Proposal 33** – 5 AAC 28.555. Descriptions of South Alaska Peninsula Area Districts and Sections. Amend regulatory description of South Alaska Peninsula groundfish district and sections as follows. Motion to support Roger Rowland second by Don Goodfellow. Discussion, housekeeping issue from ADFG, committee had no problem supporting the department and felt it was prudent to update the demarcation lines and coordinates, for the area, motion to support passed 7-0.
