Meeting Summary

The Alaska Board of Game (board) held a non-regulatory meeting, Thursday, January 10, 2013 for the purpose of receiving various informational reports and to address miscellaneous board business. Seven board members were present. The board took the following actions:

Officer Elections: Ted Spraker was elected Chairman; Nate Turner was elected Vice-Chairman.

Committee Assignments:

- Bob Mumford was assigned to serve as the board's representative on the Big Game Commercial Services Board
- Ted Spraker and Teresa Segar Albaugh were assigned to the Joint Board Committee
- Ted Spraker, Teresa Segar Albaugh, and Pete Probasco were assigned to work on the Memorandum of Understanding for the federal subsistence program.

Correspondence from the Board: The board agreed to write a letter to the Federal Subsistence Board concerning its' predator management policy.

Reissuance of Military Permits: The board directed the Department of Fish and Game to continue the status quo for reissuing hunter permits to active duty members of the military who are located in combat zones. The board did not support expanding the permits for nonmilitary support personnel or areas outside combat zones.

2013/2014 Schedule: The following dates and locations were approved:

- Work Session: October 11, 2013; Anchorage
- Arctic/Western Region: January 10 – 13, 2014; Kotzebue
- Interior Region: February 14 – 23, 2014; Fairbanks
- Statewide Regulations: March 14 – 18, 2014; Anchorage

Moratorium: The board maintained the moratorium on accepting proposals associated with the Denali wolf buffer zone.
