## NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE ALASKA BOARD OF GAME

The Alaska Board of Game proposes to consider changes to Title 5 of the Alaska Administrative Code, Chapter 92 dealing with lawful methods for Dall sheep hunting.

The Board will have a teleconferenced special meeting at 3:00 p.m. Thursday, May 28, 2015 to discuss and vote whether or not to rescind action on Proposal 207, as amended, related to aircraft restriction during sheep hunting seasons. In addition, the Board will discuss the need to establish a sheep working group and will review public and agency agenda change requests for the March 2016 meeting.
