Broad whitefish were radio tagged in the Miguakiak (Mayoriak) River (outlet of Teshekpuk lake) and Teshekpuk Lake in 2003, 2004, and 2005 and in the Meade River in 2005. See attached map, Technical Report N0. 06-04, and January 2007 project update for details and additional justification.

Nominations are based on relocation data obtained between 2003 and 2006 via fixed wing aircraft.

This nomination is for an unnamed river between the Topagoruk and Chipp rivers. The river, and lakes within the river system, were used for 2 consecutive years by a radio tagged broad whitefish tagged in the Miguakiak River (outlet of Teshekpuk lake). Subsistence fishing cabins are located along this river as well, indicating that a fair number of broad whitefish use this river annually.


